

# Heritage Academy's Twenty-First Annual American History Excursion

## “Liberty History Tour”

to

*Boston, Lexington, Concord, Plymouth, New York City*  
**Monday, October 7 - Saturday, October 12, 2019 - (6 days / 5 nights)**

Includes: Airfare, hotel rooms (quad occupancy), five full breakfasts, four dinners, one lunch, and all entrance fees.

Students are required to pay full cost of the tour unless they meet the enrollment and grade requirements for a scholarship. Students' portion must be paid according to the following schedule:

August 15, 2019	<u>\$500</u> (unless on scholarship)
Total student portion	\$2,000 (unless on scholarship)

(Less than 4 per room additional per person charges: triple- \$125, double- \$375)

There may also be a charge by the airlines for each checked bag

After August 1, 2019, a schedule of penalties for cancellations may apply to all deposited moneys.

All students must meet the following criteria in order to participate. Open only to 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders. Once student has met the requirement in the first sentence below, he/she must choose an option:

No student with a D or F in the Spring or Fall Semester of 2019 or with a major disciplinary referral will be allowed to register for this tour. Students who think they may eventually qualify may be placed on an alternate list. Once qualified, students will be allowed to register if space is available and all money due to-date must be paid immediately. All GPAs refer to the calculation at the close of the Spring semester and are cumulative of all HA high school grades. Payment will be according to one of two options:

Option 1. Students with a cumulative GPA lower than 4.0 or any student who has not been at Heritage Academy for two school years regardless of GPA, will pay the full cost of the tour.

Option 2. Students with a cumulative GPA of 4.0 and higher who have been at Heritage Academy for at least two school years will pay 75% of the cost.
